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1 General Information

Internet

Wi-Fi password: **Bobbywashere123**

If you want internet access or make phone calls outside your apartment, we recommend you buy a local sim card at the **CVMovel** store opposite to the Shell gas station. You pay CVE 1.000 for 7GB of data and CVE 200 for the SIM card. Bring your passport with you, if you want to purchase a SIM card.

Money

In Boa Vista it is possible to **pay with euros** and with the local currency CVE (Cape Verdean Escudos or Scud as the locals say). To make things easy, the local stores and restaurants convert €1 to CVE 100. Actually, €1 is CVE 110. More and more shops and restaurants accept bank or credit cards. If you want to pay cash, there are 3 options of which the first is the cheapest (best exchange rate):

1. Change euros at the local bank, here in Sal Rei
2. Get escudos from the ATM
3. Pay in euros

Energy and water

On the Island you **cannot drink tap water**¹. You can buy 5 litres of drinking water for CVE 175.

Water and electricity are very precious on the Islands.

Water is produced by desalination of seawater and electricity by the operation of diesel generators and from 3 wind turbines.

We would like to ask you to use these resources thoughtfully.

In case of **power failure** do not panic. In Boa Vista this can happen, but it normally takes less than one hour to resolve. A power failure might also mean that you will not have tap water as this is, in some apartments², provided by an electrical pump.

Laundry

Change of **towels** and **bedlinen** and **cleaning** of the apartment is done weekly. It is possible to increase this frequency at an extra cost of CVE 2.000 per cleaning.

There is a launderette where your clothes are washed and neatly folded. You can find it **here**, inside the shop gallery. Costs are CVE 500 per kilo.

Television

Some of our apartments have a TV. Note that we do not offer memberships like Amazon

Prime or Netflix nor do we offer satellite TV. If you want to watch TV you have to connect your laptop with a HDMI cable using your own subscriptions.

Check In – Check Out

Check In time is normally between 15.00 and 20.00. In case the apartment is already clean you can check-in upon arrival. After 10.00 you can always drop your luggage in your apartment.

The **Check Out** time is 10:00 or earlier. In case you wish to stay longer in the apartment to wait for your flight you can ask us and then we will check whether this is possible.

Please let us know, by Whatsapp, your flight arrival time and origin (Check In) or desired departure time (Check Out) so we can arrange a taxi for you. Costs for pick-up and return to the airport are included in the apartment rental.

Other

We do **not ask cleaning fees**, and we kindly ask you to leave the apartment as you found it. In the streets of Sal Rei and close to your apartment you will find **garbage containers** where you can drop your garbage bag.

2 Shopping

All our apartments are very close to the beach and the Sal Rei city centre. On the last two pages of this leaflet, you can find maps showing the locations of our apartments on Boa Vista. Note that Sal Rei has no house numbers and only a couple of street names.

There are plenty of **supermarkets** in Sal Rei mostly operated by Chinese entrepreneurs. You can find at least five of them around the town square.

Grocery prices are comparable to that of Europe although fresh fruit usually is usually more expensive.

There is one very big supermarket, named **Boas Compras**, which is located **here**. They have their own taxi service that brings you and your groceries back home for CVE 200.

At the centre of the town, you can find the **fruits and vegetable market**.

In case you want to buy **fresh fish**, we recommend you visit the **fish market** where you can buy tuna at prices ranging from CVE 400 to 600 a kilo. An alternative is to settle yourself at **Té Manché** at the Sal Rei city pier and buy fish directly from the returning fishermen.

Inevitably, you will be approached by **souvenir** sellers that will invite you to visit their shops. They are harmless but can sometimes be very persistent. If you want to avoid a conversation, we recommend you to not answer them in English but in another language.



3 Restaurants

There are lots of restaurants in Sal Rei and we have made a list of our favourites.

Breakfast

For an extensive breakfast buffet, you can go to the **Ouril Hotel**. The breakfast costs about CVE 600 and includes: coffee/tea, orange juice, omelette, cachupa, fruits, bread, toast, cheese and ham, butter and honey.

The **catchupa cofe shop** serves the best catchupa and cappuccino of Boa Vista next to delicious sandwiches and cakes.

Lunch

Bowl a Vista, in the Sal Rei city centre, is one of our favourites with a breath-taking view on the ocean. They serve fresh salads made from home grown vegetables and they have delicious smoothies.

A bit more expensive but still highly recommended are the Praia Carlote beach clubs **Bahia** and **Morabeza** that are a 10-15 minutes' walk along the beach (taxi CVE 300) from the city centre.

Lots of the Sal Rei residents have their lunch in a local restaurant where a Prato do Dia (plate of the day) is served for CVE 300 usually consisting of rice, beans, salad and fish or chicken. We recommend **Cá Nathalia** where you have a choice between three different plates, fish, meat or vegetarian.

Dinner

Today's favourite are **Ca Dju** and **Sodade**, both lovely restaurants with great food, service and ambiance, serving tasteful tapa dishes from kitchens all over the world.

Second best would be **El Mirador**, a Spanish restaurant with an excellent cook. Enjoy typical and delicious Spanish dishes with a spectacular view over the bay of Sal Rei.

For pizzas and Italian food, we recommend you go to **Ca Baby**. The food is "ok" but the street terrace is usually filled with cheerful Italian inhabitants of Sal Rei.



Going out

Every day, around 17.00 locals and tourists start to gather at **Wind Club** for a drink and to watch the spectacular sun set in the Sal Rei bay.

Monday night is the famous reggae night at **Morabeza**. It starts at 11pm and last till early in the morning with live music, nice cocktails and cheerful people!

We recommend the spectacular **Rooftop bar 360** at the fifth floor of the Ouril hotel. Every day they have a different “Cocktail of the day” for CVE 300. On Thursday night there is live music.



4 Activities

4.1 Fishing

Boa Vista is famous about their daily fresh fish. The local fishermen wake up around 5.00 am to go fishing with their traditional fishing boats and sell their fish at the local fish market, restaurants, and hotels.

Boat Trips and Fishing Boa Vista offers a Fish, BBQ, Snorkelling and Grill tour, especially suited to go a day out with friends or family.

For the more adventurous, they have Big Game trips where you go out on the ocean to catch the big fish like Tuna or Wahoo.

4.2 Island discovery

There is a lot of beautiful nature to see on Boa Vista and this is best done with a Quad given the fact that most locations can only be visited off road. It is hard to get lost on Boa Vista since it is an island of only 20 by 30 kilometres.

Quad rental prices range from CVE 6.600 (09.30-14.30), CVE 9.350 (09.30-18.00) to CVE 11.000 (24 hours) and the Quad is delivered at your apartment. You need to be at least 18 years old and have a driver's licence to be allowed to drive. Deposit is CVE 22.000 or €200. Whatsapp **Wanda** on +238 989 74 89 to organize this adventure for you.

Another option would be to join a **guided Quad tour** where you drive your own Quad led by an experienced guide.

We recommend the four-hour tour to the famous and breath-taking Santa Monica beach, listed in the top 10 of the world's most beautiful beaches.

The more adventurous speed lovers will fancy a **Buggy Excursion** driving mainly off road at high velocities³. An excursion takes 2 hours and about 30 km of driving.

To book these group tours, whatsapp **Wanda** on +238 989 74 89 who can also arrange for a private tour in your language.

Car rental prices are in the same order of magnitude as a Quad rental for a 4x4 Toyota Hilux which you need when you go off road. The Toyota Jimmy costs around CVE 4.500 a day.

We recommend Nanana for the best price. Whatsapp Leida on +238 982 14 36.

La Perla is a little bit more expensive but usually very responsive.

4.3 Kite surfing

Especially during the winter months, Boa Vista has a steady 14+ knots wind which, together with the sandy rock free shores and large variety of kite spots, makes the Island a kite surfers paradise.

BobbyWasHere partners with **KiteKriol**, an IKO certified kite school that is led by local heroes Joke and Yuri - the best kilters from Boa Vista. The school is located on the beach of Carlota, next to the popular beach club Morabeza, at a 10-15 minutes' walk from the Sal Rei city centre. They speak English, French, Portuguese, Spanish and Italian.

The sand is soft, and the sea is free of coral, rocks and other obstacles guaranteeing safe injury-free rides. The wind is offshore, and you can walk up to 5 meters into the sea. KiteKriol has two boats, which they use for lessons and rescue. The team watches every kiter closely and in case something happens they pick you up.

The **kite-storage** comes in very handy when you want to leave your gear at the beach.

Rescues are included if you take the storage.

You will love the friendly and relaxed atmosphere and enjoy the fresh drinks and after kite BBQs on the beach that can also be attended by non-kite surfers of course.

4.4 Whale watching

Between February and May, the waters of Boa Vista are used by the mighty humpback whales as a breeding ground. Various spectacular whale watching trips are offered in this period. Note that you are going to sail to the open ocean where it sometimes can be quite rough. This activity is not for persons with a weak stomach. Languages Dutch, English, German. 4.5 Turtle Tour

Cape Verde has the third largest population of nesting loggerhead turtles, which makes it perfect for a turtle watching tour where you can watch them laying their eggs on the beach. Most nest on the islands of Boa Vista and Sal between the months of July and October, whilst August is the peak month. Loggerhead turtles lay their eggs at night, so you leave around 08.00 pm and return around midnight. Languages Dutch, English, German.

Price is around €60 per person, all transfers from and to Sal Rei included.
